the sum of one hundred dollars, on or before the sixth day of February in
the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty six, for
value received - And whereas the said defendants on the same day
and year and at the place aforesaid made their certain other writing
obligatory sealed with their seals and now here to the Court shown, by
which said writing obligatory they promised to pay said plaintiff the
sum of thirty dollars on or before the sixth day of February in the
year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty four for
value received - which said several writings obligatory so as aforesaid
specified amount to two hundred and thirty dollars - Yet the said
