

Know all men by these presents That I, William E. Futton, and David Rogers, son of A. B. Cottler, do hereby bind and bound into Thomas West, in the penal sum of fifty dollars, the payment of which I bind myself, my heirs, jointly severally & firmly, by these presents, sealed and dated this 13th day of Octo. 1899.
